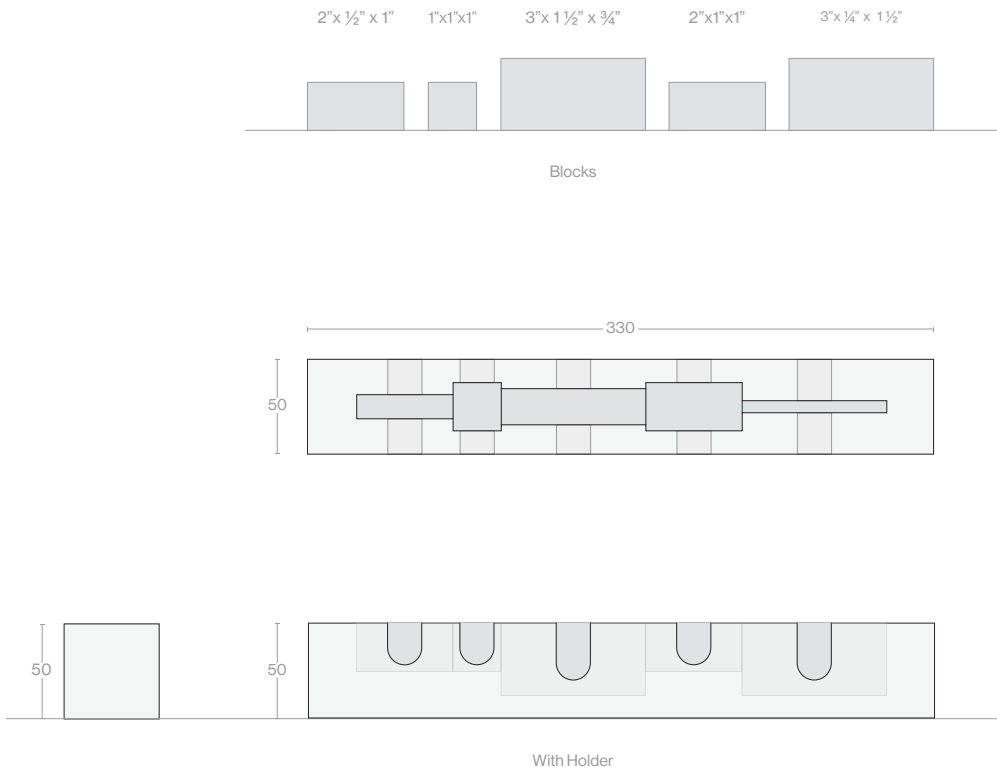


## Building Blocks

Created to maintain precision, these blocks are both tools and paperweights. Used to cut, mark, measure and press, they make work not just easier, but better. Each solid brass piece is part of an organized system of basic units. When not in use, the five pieces slip into fitted slots cut into a wooden block, completing the ensemble.

Use & Care

We find beauty in the marks of unique character – subtle variations of grain, figure, and texture inherent in materials that deepen through use and patinate over time.

Brass surfaces are left exposed to age naturally through use. If desired, the original polish can be restored using a brass-specific cleaning agent and a soft cotton cloth.

Oiled wood should be wiped with a dry cotton cloth as required. Periodically, apply a generous coat of oil with a clean cotton cloth, let it soak for an hour, then wipe off the excess.
