

Fold Jute Dhurries

Rugs

As the largest producer of jute in the world, India has a rich tradition of both hand woven and naturally dyed fibers going back generations. Locally sourced and spun into yarn, these handmade strands are woven into flat dhurries by skilled artisans.

In collaboration with craft communities in southern India, we developed a technique of folding, rolling, and dipping these simple carpets in natural, plant-based dyes to achieve bold geometric designs. Materials such as indigo, pomegranate peels, catechu, flame of the forest flowers or madder root produce rich colours that are both beautiful and fully organic.



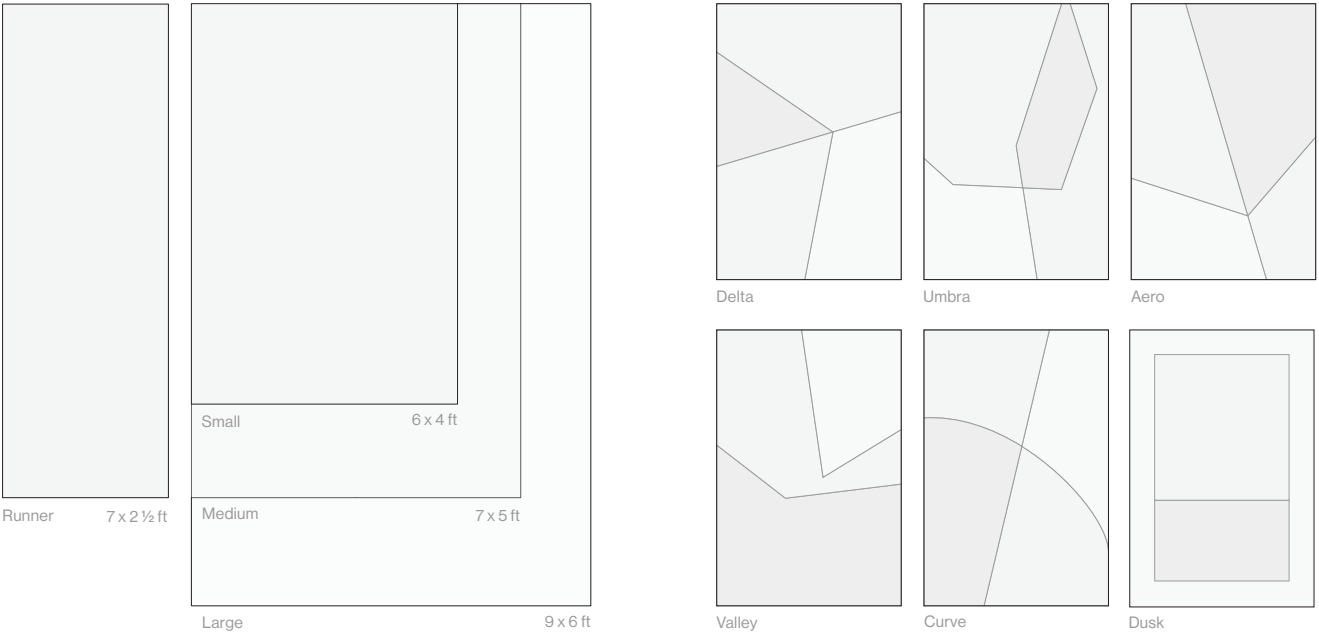

Use & Care

All carpets are handwoven, and slight unevenness is to be expected where new jute was tied in during the weaving process. Carpets should only be vacuumed using suction – rotating brushes must be avoided, as they may cause the fibres to break down.

We find beauty in the marks of unique character – subtle variations of grain, figure, and texture inherent in materials that deepen through use and patinate over time.
